

**Town of Candor

Public Hearing
September 10, 2024**

Present: Clm. Leonard, Supervisor Strosahl, Clm. Evans, Attorney Pelella, Clerk Irizarry, Superintendent Whatley, Webmaster Malone. Clm. Reichert and Clm. Rader were excused.

Others Present: Press Anne Stout, 2 Firefighters, Mr. and Mrs. Avery, 1 resident and his daughter.

At 7: 00 pm Supervisor Strosahl opened the Public Hearing with a Prayer and The Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Strosahl went on to ask if there were any questions about the Volunteer Firefighters and Ambulance Tax Exemption Law. He asked the required three times if there were any questions. There were no questions. Supervisor Strosahl closed the Public Hearing.

The Board entered into the Regular Meeting.

M-62 Clm. Leonard motioned seconded by Clm. Evans to adopt the Volunteer Firefighters and Ambulance Workers Tax Exemption into Law. All in favor.

M-63 Clm. Evans motioned seconded by Clm. Leonard to approve the minutes of August 13, 2024. All in favor.

Supervisor Strosahl stated in the General Fund \$16,822.65 was spent and in the Highway Fund \$85,888.30 was spent.

M-64 Clm. Leonard motioned seconded by Clm. Evans to approve the vouchers that have been signed. Roll Call Vote: Leonard-aye, Strosahl-aye, Evans-aye.

There was a budget transfer: From Contingency Fund of \$886.00 to Dog Control – Contractual Fund of \$886.00 to cover the medical treatment of a dog at Cornell.

M-65 Clm. Leonard motioned seconded by Clm. Evans to approve the Budget Transfer of \$886. All in favor.

Board of Appeals: Clm. Leonard stated the Board of Appeals had a working meeting and they are still trying to fill the open position on the Board. They are hopeful they have an interested candidate.

Buildings and Grounds: Supervisor Strosahl is still trying to dig the hole for the light pole conduit. He stated he may get the Highway Superintendents help.

He also stated there is one more Farmers Market in October then the water will be turned off at the Pavilion.

Cemetery: Clm. Leonard said to keep the notice of available plots at the Newman (Lower Fairfield) Cemetery on the door until he finds out the proper time to remove it. He will also work on the physical addresses of the cemetery list to end the confusion of a couple.

Supervisor Strosahl stated he'd be okay to see one more mow of the cemeteries before fall.

Code Enforcement: Clm. Evans read a summary of Code Enforcer Yacopinos report. There were 6 permits issued. There are 28 active permits in the town from the year 2020, 11 permits completed and 4 open violations. The active permits haven't been "closed out" from 2020 and Code Enforcer Yacopino is working on them.

EMS: Supervisor Strosahl reported for EMS Hammond who was absent. There were 71 calls, 48 billable calls, 1 dropped "code 2" call, and 7 "code 2" calls covered.

Highway: Superintendent Whatley stated Thursday they are done paving and the stone and oiling will be done at the end of the month. The truck up for bid is at \$10,000 and will post tomorrow. The generator is at \$850 and closes tomorrow as well.

Planning Board: Clm. Evans stated at the Planning Board meeting they had 2 applicants for the open position .1 dropped out and the other, Daniel Reinhart, is a candidate for the position. The Planning Board requests the Town Board to approve Daniel Reinhardt to be the new member.

M-66 Clm. Evans motioned seconded by Clm. Leonard to approve Daniel Reinhart as the new Planning Board member. All in favor.

A workshop meeting is planned to close up the Comprehensive Plan and work on some of the Town Laws added Clm. Evans.

New Business

Webmaster Malone stated there is an annual zoom conference for Digital Towpath on the 27th of September from 10 to 3. She asked The Board to be paid her hourly wage for that training.

M-67 Supervisor Strosahl motioned seconded by Clm. Evans to pay Webmaster Malone for the training. Roll Call Vote: Leonard-aye, Strosahl-aye, Evans-aye.

Next Supervisor Strosahl suggested to set a time for the Budget Workshop. Thursday September 26, 2024 was decided on at 5:30 pm.

Privilege of the Floor: A neighbor of the Adrenaline Go-Kart Raceway took the floor next. He stated traffic was heavy at times and it disturbs the peace at times. It runs later than originally stated of 9 pm and he hopes it does not continue to grow beyond what it is now. He wanted his opinion in the minutes "for the record" he said. It began once every other week then happening almost every weekend he said. Supervisor Strosahl assured him that the Town Law for Raceways will be adjusted for the next race season since there is only one race left. This neighbor is more interested in horses and quiet. He would prefer the races end at 9 pm like originally agreed to. The Board thanked him for his input.
